We are incalculably richer for their presence in our lives and we shall be greatly diminished by their absence.

END OF YEAR MEDICATION REMINDER

Please pick up any unused medication(s) that your child has in the school office by June 11th. The school cannot store medication in the office over the summer and unclaimed medications will be brought to the clinic for proper disposal. NOTE- This also includes epi-pens and inhalers.



Remember, if your child needs any medication(s) during the school day, including all over-the-counter medications, such as Tylenol, Benadryl, and Advil, a new medication authorization form must be completed and signed by both a physician and the parent/guardian each school year. These forms are available in the school office. In addition, the medication must be brought to school in the original container, properly labeled with the student's name.
