SUBJECT: Crime Prevention Flyer (0063-14-CID137) – Unauthorized Trash Disposal within U.S. Army Garrison (USAG)-Ansbach

1. **PURPOSE:** This Crime Prevention Flyer shall provide background information on continued unauthorized trash disposal and to remind the community of USAG Policy Letter 27, Recycling and Solid Waste Disposal within USAG-Ansbach. This information was collected by the Ansbach CID Office.
2. **BACKGROUND:** There has been a noted increase of the unauthorized disposal of waste generated from off-post in the USAG-Ansbach area. Soldiers and family members who reside in privately rented homes/apartments are bringing their trash onto the installation for disposal and not separating their trash as required by the German law. This unauthorized disposal creates an increase in billing to USAG-Ansbach along with penalties resulting from the failure to properly separate trash.
3. **POLICY:** Recycling is the law in Germany. Everyone must abide by the host nation laws. Host nation ordinance requires separation of trash where generated (i.e., at the home or workplace). Recyclables purchased on post (e.g., from AAFES, Commissary, etc.) may be disposed of at recycle collection points within the USAG-Ansbach.
 - a. On-post employees must separate and deposit their recyclable waste into the appropriate receptacles.
 - b. Off-post residents (military and civilian) must separate deposit their recyclable waste into the appropriate receptacles at designated off-post locations. They may not bring any trash or bulk trash onto any military installation for disposal. Trash generated off post needs to be disposed of off post. The Katterbach and the Storck Recycling Centers are not to be used for off-post waste. All German communities collect trash and recyclable items. They also have provisions for disposing bulk trash.
 - c. On-post residents (includes leased-housing) must separate their household waste into those items that are recyclable and what remains is trash. You are authorized to use nearby dumpsters for your trash disposal. You may also use the Recycle Center at either Katterbach or Storck Barracks.

d. Military units may not place any De-Militarized (DEMIL) items, hazardous waste or recyclables into any trash dumpsters anywhere. DEMIL items may not be taken to the Recycling Centers. DEMIL items need to be taken to the Defense Re-utilization Marketing Office (DRMO) for correct disposal IAW Army policies and German law.

4. The primary recycling center for residents residing in Katterbach is the Wertstoffhof Ansbach, 48 Adalbert-Pilipp-Strasse, Ansbach 91522 and Storck Barracks is the Wertstoffhof Bad Windsheim, 8 Walkmuehla, Bad Windsheim 91438.
