MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: 12th Combat Aviation Brigade (CAB) Dining Facility Dress Code Policy

1. Purpose: To prescribe a standard dress code for personnel dining, working, or visiting the USAG-Ansbach Dining Facilities, respectively.
2. Applicability: This policy applies to all patrons of the USAG- Ansbach Garrison Dining Facilities located in Katterbach Kaserne and Storck Barracks.
3. Policy: Effective immediately, patrons entering the above mentioned dining facilities whether in civilian clothing or military uniform, including the Army Physical Fitness Training uniform will conform to proper behavior, dress, and grooming standards. All personnel will ensure that their clothing and shoes are free of dirt, mud, grease, and any other unclean substance before entering the facility.
  - a. The wearing of civilian attire should be a matter of personal pride. No order or policy could possibly address all that is acceptable or unacceptable civilian clothing. Wearing civilian clothing that presents a conservative clean, inoffensive and neat appearance is the standard for all active duty personnel assigned to all Army Installations. While on USAG-Ansbach, retired military, family members of Armed Forces personnel, DoD Civilians employees and all guest will adhere to the same standards outlined within this memorandum.
  - b. Shoes and boots are required. Open toe shoes are authorized, if in good taste. Bare feet are not allowed at any time.
  - c. Individuals authorized to subsist in USAG-Ansbach dining facilities are entitled to dine in an atmosphere that is pleasant and in good taste. A major factor of such a policy is the appearance of the patrons. In order to assist in the attainment of the policy the following dress standards are established.

**(1) Military Attire**

- (a) When the military uniform is worn in the dining facility, it will be complete, clean, and neat.
- (b) Headgear will not be worn.

(c) No mixed uniform will be allowed (military uniforms with civilian clothing or items from different uniforms worn together) unless authorized by AR 670-1.

(d) Undershirts, either white or tan in color, will not be worn as outer garments in the dining facilities.

(e) Physical Fitness Training Uniforms (summer or winter) are authorized for wear in dining facilities. Soiled, wet, or dirty PT uniform will not be authorized for wear in the dining facility. These Soldiers will receive a Take-Out Plate.

**(2) Civilian Attire**

(a) Clothing designed as under garments will not be worn as outer garments.

(b) Revealing clothing such as halter, string y-back muscle shirts, tube tops, see through clothing or shirts exposing the midriff area will not be worn. Underwear worn as outerwear or exposed underwear will not be authorized.

(c) Excessively short shorts, bathing attire, cut off shorts, or any other garments that reveal any portion of the buttocks are not authorized for wear in the dining facilities.

(d) Clothing which makes disparaging comments concerning the Military / United States Government.

(e) Trousers, pants, or jeans cannot sag or be cut off to where pocket lining are visible.

(f) No bathing suits.

(g) Headgear can be worn in good taste. However, hats will not be worn sideways or backwards.

(h) No torn, cut, or worn clothing.

(i) Flip flops / shower shoes will not be authorized.

(j) All civilian attire will be in good taste, free of obscene language; slanderous or vulgar words / drawings depicting drugs, drug paraphernalia, sexually suggestive, advocate drug use and must not be offensive to others.

(k) All personnel entering the Dining Facility will adhere to this dress code. Personnel not conforming to this dress code will be directed by the Dining Facility Manager or Senior Military personnel to leave the facility.

(l) No sleepwear (pajamas, night shirts, slippers, etc.).

(n) No backpacks allowed in the dining areas of the dining facilities due to force protection requirements.
