Items Required



- ✓ Sponsor's Orders
- ✓ Proof of Child's Eligibility
Legal Guardianship papers, Child's Military ID card, or Birth Certificate
- ✓ Parent(s) Home and Work Information
- ✓ Email Address
- ✓ Proof of Parent(s) Income
- ✓ 2 Local Emergency Release Designee
- ✓ Child Health Assessment
(Due within 30 days of enrollment)
- ✓ Sports Physical (if applicable)
- ✓ Child's Official Shot Records (if applicable)
- ✓ Deployment Orders (if applicable)
- ✓ Family Care Plan (if applicable)
(Dual/Single Military-Due within 30 days of enrollment)

Waitlist Priority

Priority is given to single/dual military, DoD
Civilian with working spouse, Surviving Spouse
and Wounded Warrior



Special Needs - EFMP

Inform CYs Services staff of any concerns during the registration process with the CYs Services Health and Developmental Screening Form


